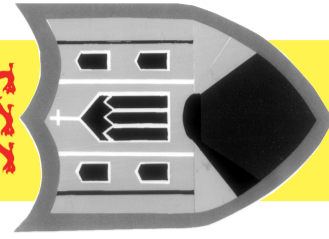

## LOCAL RULES - GENERAL

- MOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-1)**
  - Stones in Bunkers
  - When playing any hole other than the 18th, the white posts defining the boundary at the 18th hole are obstructions.
- IMMOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**
  - Concrete Road Blocks
  - Septic Tank adjacent to 18th Fairway
  - Newly laid artificial Paths
  - Metalled roads i.e. Crossing the 1st, 2nd, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 13th, 14th, 18th, parallel to the left of the 3rd green, behind the 9th green and the main road on all occasions when the ball is not out of bounds
  - Mine Shaft Capping / Cairns
  - Distance Marker Posts
  - Trees with Rabbit Guards
  - Wheel Ruts on closely mown areas
- G.U.R. (Rule 25)**
  - Horse Hoof Marks
- All roads and tracks other than those listed above, fences stone building by 13th tee, are an integral part of the course.
- A ball lying in wheel rut on the green may be lifted and placed not nearer the hole.
- When a ball has struck overhead wires it **must** be replayed.

The Birdie Sweep is an integral part of the Competition. Only properly completed cards will qualify. Distance posts are 150 yards to the centre of the green. Temporary local rules are displayed on the club notice boards and in the Professional's shop when applicable.

Please Note: This is Common Land, please give way to pedestrians.

- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)**
  - A ball coming to rest either in, or over any boundary hedge, fence wall or marked post enclosing land which is not part of the course.
  - The Clubhouse, car park and practise area as defined by kerb stones, footpath handrail by the 1st, fence and posts.
  - 2nd Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the left of the tee up to the track.
  - 3rd Hole.** A ball played over the white posts to the left of the tee between the red and white marker posts
  - 4th Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the right of the 5th tee.
  - 5th Hole.** A ball played over the white posts to the right of the tee between the red and white marker posts and beyond white posts at the back of the green.
  - 7th Hole.** A ball played over the white posts to the right of the tee between the red and white marker posts. After the last red and white marker post the road is out of bounds.
  - 8th Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the right of the second.
  - 9th Hole.** A ball played on to the first green or fairway, or on or over the main road to the right of the 9th fairway.
  - 10th Hole.** A ball played on or over the main road to the left of the tee.
  - 13th Hole.** A ball played onto or over the road to the right of the tee and past the white posts behind the green.
  - 14th Hole.** A ball played onto or over the quarry boundary wall or white posts to the right of the tee up to the 16th tee.
  - 18th Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the right of the tee up to a line between the red and white marker posts, or in or behind the hedge bordering the 1st tee.

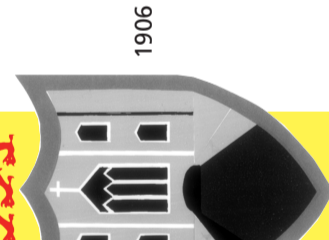

- MOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-1)**
  - Stones in Bunkers
  - When playing any hole other than the 18th, the white posts defining the boundary at the 18th hole are obstructions.
- IMMOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**
  - Concrete Road Blocks
  - Septic Tank adjacent to 18th Fairway
  - Newly laid artificial Paths
  - Metalled roads i.e. Crossing the 1st, 2nd, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 13th, 14th, 18th, parallel to the left of the 3rd green, behind the 9th green and the main road on all occasions when the ball is not out of bounds
  - Mine Shaft Capping / Cairns
  - Distance Marker Posts
  - Trees with Rabbit Guards
  - Wheel Ruts on closely mown areas
- G.U.R. (Rule 25)**
  - Horse Hoof Marks
- All roads and tracks other than those listed above, fences stone building by 13th tee, are an integral part of the course.
- A ball lying in wheel rut on the green may be lifted and placed not nearer the hole.
- When a ball has struck overhead wires it **must** be replayed.

  - 2nd Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the left of the tee up to the track.
  - 3rd Hole.** A ball played over the white posts to the left of the tee between the red and white marker posts
  - 4th Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the right of the 5th tee.
  - 5th Hole.** A ball played over the white posts to the right of the tee between the red and white marker posts and beyond white posts at the back of the green.
  - 7th Hole.** A ball played over the white posts to the right of the tee between the red and white marker posts. After the last red and white marker post the road is out of bounds.
  - 8th Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the right of the second.
  - 9th Hole.** A ball played on to the first green or fairway, or on or over the main road to the right of the 9th fairway.
  - 10th Hole.** A ball played on or over the main road to the left of the tee.
  - 13th Hole.** A ball played onto or over the road to the right of the tee and past the white posts behind the green.
  - 14th Hole.** A ball played onto or over the quarry boundary wall or white posts to the right of the tee up to the 16th tee.
  - 18th Hole.** A ball played over the marker posts to the right of the tee up to a line between the red and white marker posts, or in or behind the hedge bordering the 1st tee.
